## 2017 MOTOR TOUR INFORMATION

## WE RETURN TO THE TRADITIONAL POINT-TO-POINT FORMAT

**Friday, September 8<sup>th</sup>:** Between 4 PM and 9 PM, Motor Tour registration and roadie gathering will be at the **Best Western Plus Coach House Inn** at 2535 N Glenstone Avenue in Springfield. We reserved a block of 25 rooms at the discounted rate of \$79.99 (one king or two queen beds, plus tax). Call (417) 862-0701 for reservations and ask for the Route 66 Association Motor Tour rate. Reserve your room by August 25, 2017. After that date, this rate will NOT be available.

**Saturday, September 9<sup>th</sup>.** Breakfast starts at 7 AM for guests of the BW Plus Coach House Inn. After gathering for a brief driver meeting at 9 AM, we will journey eastward on our own. We will tour the Bennett Spring Fish Hatchery at 1 PM. This tour is free, and no reservation is required.

The **Days Inn & Suites** at 97 Ozark Drive in Cuba is the host motel on Saturday night. We reserved a block of 25 rooms at the discounted rate of \$50.00 or \$55.00 (one king or two queen beds, respectively, plus tax). Call (573) 885-0100 for reservations and ask for the Route 66 Association Motor Tour rate. Reserve your room by August 25, 2017. After that date, this rate will NOT be available.

The **Wagon Wheel Motel** at 901 East Washington Boulevard (Historic Route 66) in Cuba is another option for your Saturday night stay. We have not reserved any rooms at this vintage boutique motel, but they will be happy to tell you about their lovingly restored rooms and rates. Call (573) 885-3411 for information and reservations. If you want to stay here, make your reservation soon—they will probably fill up fast!

**Dottie's Family Restaurant**, located at 5922 MO-19 (part of the Midwest Petroleum Travel Plaza at the MO-19 / I-44 interchange in Cuba), will host dinner on Saturday night. Dinner will be their regular buffet-style service. Dinner, including dessert, is \$10.99 per person (subject to change) and is payable at the door. Discuss the day with other roadies, look at the Route 66 murals, listen to a presentation on Route 66, and place bids in the Silent Auction. The festivities begin at 6:30 PM, but you may arrive at Dottie's and dine whenever you like.

**Sunday, September 10<sup>th</sup>.** Breakfast starts at 7 AM for guests of the Day's Inn. At 8 AM, there will be a short nondenominational worship service. There will be no drivers meeting on Sunday, but we will plan on leaving by 9:00 AM. We will continue on our journey eastward to Route 66 State Park in Eureka.

The Motor Tour will end with a BBQ meal from Super Smokers served at the Dogwood Shelter inside **Route 66 State Park** located at 97 North Outer Road, Eureka. The shelter is located in the "Times Beach" area of the State Park and is accessible only from I-44 eastbound exit 265 "Williams Road". Note that getting to the shelter includes driving on a segment of two-lane Route 66 west of the old bridge. After lunch, a walk "Down by the Riverside" to the Meramec River will be offered (weather permitting). Cost of lunch, including drink and dessert, is \$15.00 per person and will be available by 12 Noon. Route 66 State Park Visitor Center will be open as well. **You must pre-register for lunch.**
