2018 MOTOR TOUR INFORMATION

FOLLOWING THE TRADITIONAL POINT-TO-POINT FORMAT

Friday, September 7th: Between 4 PM and 9 PM, Motor Tour registration and roadie gathering will be at the **Best Western Kirkwood Inn** at 1200 S Kirkwood Road in Kirkwood. We reserved a block of 25 rooms at the discounted rate of \$89.99 (one king or two queen beds, plus tax). Call (314) 821-3950 for reservations; request the Route 66 Association Motor Tour rate. Tell the motel if you have any special requests. Reserve your room by August 24, 2018. After that date, this rate will NOT be available.

OPTIONAL FRIDAY EXCURSION: Ride Amtrak's westbound "Missouri River Runner" train (#313) from the historic Kirkwood, MO station around 4 PM to Washington, MO. The route parallels Route 66 through Pacific and goes through two tunnels on its way to Washington. You will have about three hours to dine and explore this quaint river town. Board the eastbound train (#316) around 8 PM in Washington and return to Kirkwood station around 9 PM. No arrangements will be made; you will be on your own (besides joining others on the train). You must purchase round-trip tickets from Amtrak in advance (about \$25 per person). There is no ticket agent at either station. Look for a PDF with more details on our website (coming soon). Please phone or E-mail Robert if you are taking the excursion so we can account for you at registration on Friday night!

Saturday, September 8th. Breakfast starts at 6 AM for guests of the BW Kirkwood Inn. After gathering for a brief driver meeting at 9 AM, we will journey westward on our own. We have arranged to take an approximately 30-minute ride on the Wabash, Frisco & Pacific Railroad at 10:30 AM. The WF&P is a unique 12-inch gauge miniature railroad just off Route 66, and is unknown to most Roadies! The charge for this optional activity is \$5; this includes the boarding fee. You must register for this optional activity.

Liberty Lodge St. Robert/Fort Leonard Wood at 140 Old Route 66 in St Robert is the host motel on Saturday night. We reserved a block of 25 rooms at the discounted rate of \$49.00 (plus tax) for a standard room. Call (573) 336-3121 for reservations; request the Route 66 Association Motor Tour rate. Tell the motel if you have any special requests. Reserve your room by August 24, 2018. After that date, this rate will NOT be available.

Hampton Inn St. Robert/Ft. Leonard Wood, located at 103 St. Robert Blvd. in St Robert will host dinner on Saturday night. Main courses will be chicken piccata and a pasta dish, plus sides, dessert, and drink. Dinner is \$20.00 per person. You must register and pay in advance for this meal. Discuss the day with other roadies, listen to a presentation on Route 66, and place bids in the Silent Auction*. Festivities begin at 6:30 PM, with dinner service starting at 7 PM.

Sunday, September 9th. At 7:30 AM, there will be a short nondenominational worship service. There will be no drivers meeting on Sunday, but we will plan on leaving by 8:00 AM. We will continue on our journey westward to Carthage. The railroad museum in Springfield will be open especially for us that day, is a suggested stop, and fits in very well with this year's theme.

The Motor Tour will end at Sirloin Stockade located at 1027 W Central, Carthage. Order off the menu or dine from the buffet (not included with registration fee). Arrive by 1 PM in order to dine with others on the Tour. After lunch, at about 2:30 PM, you could continue west into Joplin and on to the Kansas State line and Galena, KS.
